What will the course cover?

This programme is a journey into who you are as a coach. You'll develop your personal coaching philosophy, deepen your self-knowledge, and build the confidence to lead with a coaching approach, coach internally, or grow a coaching practice - all grounded in the latest neuroscience and coaching research.

Each module focuses on a distinct stage of the coaching process, blending theory, science, and real practice. You'll rotate through the roles of coach, coachee, and observer - and take your learning straight into your work between sessions.

The Norfolk retreat is an immersive few days near the sea where the learning goes deeper and the cohort becomes a genuine community. This is where it really gets 'in the muscle'.

Throughout the programme you will:

- Work with 3-4 real coaching clients outside the programme (40 hours total), one of whom features in your case study
- Complete 50 hours of self-study - reading, webinars, podcasts, TED talks etc
- Keep a reflective journal, reviewed at each module
- Take part in two group supervisions and two 1:1 supervision sessions (held online)
- Record one coaching session to discuss in your 1:1 supervision
- Close with a 1-day Integration to demonstrate your growth and leave as a fully validated coach
